The House met at 3.00 p.m.

*[The Speaker (Mr. Mung'ata) in the Chair]***PRAYERS****COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR
RE-OPENING AFTER SHORT RECESS****Hon. Speaker:** Welcome to this new session. Proceed. Yes?

Hon. Maitha: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and the Hon. Members present. Welcome back to this session, last session of this financial year. Mr. Speaker, I want to enquire to know, we sat in the Assembly before we proceeded to the last session of this month; before we went for recess and we agreed and passed unanimously in the Assembly that the proceedings of the Assembly as the chamber is undergoing renovation, shall be done at Mavoko and you remember very well we had the subject of Mavoko and Matuu. I don't know what has changed. We have not convened to rethink of the same. Can you guide us on that, Mr. Speaker? Thank you.

Hon. Speaker: A decision had been reached Hon. Member, Hon. Maitha that we have our sessions held here, in a *Kamukunji* that was held here in this Assembly last session. Proceed.

*(Applause)***Hon. Speaker:** *(Addressing a member attempting speak)* Overruled. Proceed.*(A Member stands in his place)*

Hon. Ndawa, you are out of order. Leave the chamber.

*(Applause)***Hon. (Ms.) Ndawa:** I cannot leave the chamber because I am not out of order.**Hon. Speaker:** Leave the chamber.*(Loud consultations)***Hon. Kitheka:** Point of clarification, Mr. Speaker.

Hon. (Ms.) Ndawa: Why are we here? Look at the way everybody is seated. This is not a chamber.

Hon. Speaker: We are saying you are out of order.

(Loud consultations)

I have made a ruling. Hon. Kitheka, please sit down. Sit down. Hon. Ndawa, leave the chamber. That is the ruling of the Chair. Hon. Ndawa, I am still on you, leave the chamber. We said we must maintain discipline in this chamber. Hon. Ndawa, leave the chamber. Serjeant-at-Arms, assist her out of the chamber. You cannot talk in this House without the permission of the Chair. If you talk you, will be out of order

Hon. Kitheka: Mr. Speaker---

Hon. Speaker: Let us finish that issue first. Hon. Kitheka, sit down. Hon. Members, in a Kamukunji that all of you attended, we said that we shall all---

(Loud consultations)

Hon Speaker: Order! Order! Hon. Maitha.

Hon. Maitha: Mr. Speaker, I am saying if we cannot pass rules in House and implement them, Mr. Speaker, I think we are heading in the wrong direction. We don't want to be in a House that cannot follow the law.

Hon. Speaker: Can you sit down, Hon. Maitha. Can you be seated? Gazetting of the Assembly is the entire Assembly, not the chamber. We are within the precincts of the Assembly.

Hon. Maitha: Mr. Speaker we have not sat down and decided.

(Loud consultations)

Hon. Kitheka: But you made a ruling that we move to Mavoko. When was it changed? We spent the whole day discussing the same.

Hon. Speaker: Hon. Kitheka, have a seat.

(Loud consultations)

Order, order! Hon. Maitha, you are out of order.

(Loud consultations)

Order! Order!

(The House degenerated into grave disorder)
