

**MACHAKOS COUNTY ASSEMBLY****OFFICIAL REPORT****Thursday, 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2015**

The House met at 2.38 p.m.

*[The Speaker (Mr. Mung'ata) in the Chair]***PRAYERS****Hon. Speaker:** Good afternoon. Let us proceed, Clerk.**PAPER LAID****Hon. Speaker:** In the absence of the member, the matter is deferred back to the House Business Committee. Proceed.**STATEMENTS****Hon. Muthuka:** Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir, and the rest of the house. Mr. Speaker, Sir, I stand here to re-introduce statements that I requested on 30th April, 2015. Mr. Speaker, I wish to seek the following statements;**MAVOLONI WATER PROJECT**

The position of construction of Mavoloni water project at a cost of Ksh. 2.7 million since the contractor abandoned the project for the last nine months. I wish to get the plan of action and expected completion date.

**KISIIKI MARKET STALLS**

I wish to seek a statement to know why the Kisiiki market stalls has stalled for more than eight months. I wish to get information on the total cost of the project and the expected completion date.

**KISIIKI-MUUSINI-KIWANZA-NYS ROAD**

I do wish to get information on the Ndalani ward phase two roads construction since some parts like Kisiiki-Muusini-Kiwanza-NYS road, which had been awarded to Microbit Systems Limited at a cost of Ksh. 2.6 million had been done by KeRRA. I wish to know when the roads will be done, since we are two months to the closure of the year.

#### KISIIKI-KILUMANTHI-UVAUNI-KISIIKI RING ROAD

I also wish to know when the works for Kisiiki-Kilumanthi-Uvauni-Kisiiki ring road which had been awarded to Multi-Smart Limited Company last year at a cost of Ksh. 4.5 million will start and the expected completion date. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.
