STATEMENT

BUSINESS FOR THE HOUSE FROM 20TH TO 22ND SEPTEMBER, 2016

Hon. (Ms.) Ndinda: Mr. Speaker, Sir, I stand under Standing Order 41 (2a) where during the statement hour, a member of the House Business committee designated by the committee for that purpose, shall every Thursday or on the last sitting day, for not more than ten minutes, present and lay on the table a statement informing the House of the business coming before the House in the following week.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the House Business committee met today, Thursday, 15th September, 2016 and pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 151 (5), balloted business for 20th and 22nd September, 2016. Mr. Speaker, Sir, the committee did not ballot any business for 21st September, 2016 to allow members participate in the public participation of Machakos County Finance Bill, 2016 in their respective sub counties. On Thursday afternoon, 22nd September, 2016, we will have a report of Justice and Legal Affairs committee on the benchmarking visit to Kilifi County Assembly, which will be a continuation. The same day, we shall have a report of Agriculture and Cooperative Development committee on the status of tractors in the county. Thank you, Mr. Speaker, Sir.
