#### 1. <u>STATEMENTS</u>

### (a) <u>Statement on Extension of reporting time – Hon. Daniel Ndwiki- Chairperson, Lands and Energy Committee</u>

**Honorable Speaker**, Standing Order 41(2)(b) provides that, a member may make a Statement relating to their responsibilities in the House or the activities of a Committee;

**Honorable Speaker**, on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2023, Hon. Dominic Maitha, the MCA Muthwani Ward sought two Statements from the Departments of Energy and Lands on the following matters;

- i) Why the Department has never implemented provision of flood lights in Muthwani Ward in the Financial years of 2021/2022, 2022/2023 and FY 2023/2024.
- ii) The plans which the Department has to ensure a 24 Hour economy in Muthwani Ward as per H.E, The Governor's Speech delivered in this Assembly on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022,
- iii) The work plan of the Public Utility Task force as regards visitation to Muthwani Ward to ascertain the status of encroached public utilities.

The Statements were committed to the Committee on Lands and Energy to inquire into the matters raised then report within 14 days which will lapse tomorrow on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

Hon. Speaker, on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023 via letters reference *MKSCA/PCS/CMM/L&E/VOL.1/15* and *MKSCA/PCS/CMM/L&E/VOL.1/16*, the Committee wrote to the Chief Officers Departments of Energy and Lands respectively seeking responses to the stated Statements. On 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 during a Committee sitting, the Committee was notified that the responses have not been received yet.

**Honorable Speaker**, I wish to therefore request that Lands and Energy Committee be granted a further fourteen (14) days to inquire for the information from the respective Departments and also carry out fact finding mission at the Ward in question.
