**Honorable Speaker**, that aware that the County Assembly's oversights function is one of the cornerstones of democracy; Aware that oversight is a means for holding the County executive accountable for its actions and for ensuring that it implements policies in accordance with the laws and budget passed by the County Assembly;

Acknowledging that Article 183(3) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides that the County Executive Committee shall provide the County Assembly with full and regular reports on matters relating to the County; further aware that Article 185(3) states that the County Assembly while respecting the principle of separation of powers, may exercise oversight over the County Executive Committee and any other County Executive Organs;

Cognizant that the Transport, Roads and Public Works Committee is established under second Schedule Standing Order 190 and is mandated to deal with all matters related to county transport, including county

roads; Aware that the Transport, Roads and Public Works Committee received report on status of rural roads projects from the Department of Roads and Transport, conducted several site visits to ascertain the status of the sampled roads as indicated in the report, held meetings with the County Executive Committee Member and compiled this report;
