8***MOTION – <u>APPROVAL OF MOTION ONPUTTING UP MEASURES TO HANDLE</u> TEETHING IN CHILDREN

(Hon. Judas Ndawa – Leader of Minority/ MCA: Matuu Ward)

Honorable Speaker; THAT aware that Article 43(1)(a) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides that; every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive health care; further aware that Article 53(1) (c) and (d)of the same Constitution states that every child has the right to basic nutrition, shelter and health care; and to be protected from abuse, neglect, harmful cultural practices, all forms of violence, inhuman treatment and punishment and hazardous or exploitive labour;

Aware that cutting of a child's teeth gum is a cultural practice common in the Kamba Community where mothers or caregivers use ash tone or coarse sodium bicarbonate stone to rub off the gum pads of a baby until they bleed just when teething is about to happen;

Further aware that in other cases, sharp objects like razor blades and knives are used to cut the gums and expose the underlying teeth buds and aware that in all these cases, the procedures are done without anesthesia with the child bearing immense pain;

Cognizant of the fact that several of these children have also died due to sepsis since the wounds inflicted in the mouth become infected and bacterial infections spread to the whole body causing sepsis which is fatal; Aware that in the last one month Matuu Level 4 Hospital has lost nine children from sepsis caused by gum cutting;

Honorable Speaker, I wish to move the motion **THAT** this House urges the County Government of Machakos through the Department of Health to put up measures to ensure that:

- (i) Mothers are sensitized on how to handle teething babies both at pre- natal and post natal clinics.
- (ii) Community Health Promoters are well equipped with knowledge to sensitize mothers and caregivers to shun gum cutting and embrace modern health practices of teething.
