**(b) Statement on beneficiaries on the distribution of seeds to farmers in Masinga Central Ward ; (Hon. Joshua Mwonga-MCA,Masinga Central Ward)**

**Honorable Speaker, Aware** Article 43 (1) (c) of the Constitution recognizes that every person has a right to be free from hunger and to have adequate food of acceptable quality.

**Honorable Speaker, further aware** that one of the objectives of the Machakos County Agricultural Development Fund Act, 2014 as provided for in Section 5(b) is to support growth and development in Agriculture and enhance productivity in the Agriculture sector by facilitating the provision of farm inputs to farmers including fertilizers, seeds, agro-chemicals, animal breeding, animal drugs and feeds, artificial insemination services and fishing equipment and supplies. This clearly mandates the County Government to ensure that every resident of Machakos County is provided with certified seeds.

**Acknowledging that** the Department of Agriculture and Food Security was allocated a budget of Kshs. 38Million in the FY 2023/2024 for the purchase of certified crop seeds.

Further aware that H.E the Governor launched distribution of seeds in Masinga Central Ward on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.

(c) **Statement on the lay off and employment of Community Health Promoters ;( Hon. Raphael Lucky Nzau-MCA,Matungulu West ward**

**Honorable Speaker,**

**AWARE THAT** Article 43 (1) (a) of the Constitution of Kenya provides that every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive health care;

**AWARE THAT** Part 2 (2) (a) and (c) of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya provides that the functions of the County government include County health services, including County health facilities and the promotion of primary health care;

**FURTHER AWARE THAT** on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 Her Excellency The Governor Hon. Wavinya Ndeti launched a total of 2,820 Community Health Promoters who have been offered basic training to serve as first responders at the primary healthcare stage, in line with the National Government agenda of universal health coverage.
