**(b) Response to a statement sought on operationalization of Kangundo Bus terminus- (Hon. Brian Kisila, Chairperson, Decentralized Units and County Administration Committee)**

Honorable Speaker, a statement was sought by Hon. Dickson Maundu on what the County is doing to ensure that Kangundo town bus terminus is fully operationalized.

The sought statement was conveyed to the Roads, Transport and Public Works Department via a letter Ref. No MKSCA/ADMN/DUC/VOL.1 /70 dated 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2023. The letter was responded to, through a letter Ref No. GMC/TR&PW/COUNTYASSEMBLY/VOL.II/82 conveying the following information:

That Kangundo Bus Park was constructed in 1990s by the World Bank during Tala-Kangundo Council and later upgraded to its current status in later years. It has a capacity of 25 vehicles according to the sub-divisions of the slots. It is well lit at night with a Mulika Mwizi at the entrance. The business community has installed a few stores around the bus park. There is a washroom block that requires to be operationalized.

The County Government of Machakos through the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works is aware of the situation in Kangundo Bus Park. That the Department is also aware of how the non-operationalization has negative impact it on the business community and the economy of the County in general.

The Government is also aware that the Bus Park is neglected over the time and to some extend vandalized some of the steel that covers the drainages.

That Kangundo commuters are dropped at Tala from different picking points and incur extra cost to Kangundo by Boda Bodas even at late hours greatly affecting women, children and Persons living With Disabilities.

In its effort to curb this problem, the Department through the County Executive Committee Member has approved letters of no objection to several SACCOs mandating them to terminate at Kangundo Bus park as per NTSA requirement. The routes are distributed on demand by the County Transport & Safety Committee (CTSC) where CECM — Roads, Transport & Public Works is the Chairperson. The Department over time has interrogated the Chairpersons of SACCOs authorized to terminate at the Bus park and has captured some challenges:-

1. They have tried severally to pick and drop at the bus park and every time the community does not cooperate or they lack awareness and still board Boda Bodas to Tala, eventually they give up due to losses in business.
2. The SACCOs mandated to operate Nairobi — Kangundo route terminate at Tala with exception of a few who end their day at Kangundo.

3. The SACCOs at Tala Bus park are the same that have been given extension routes to Kangundo and try to block other SACCOs from the route due to fear of competition.

### **Way forward**

The Department intends to;

1. Compel the SACCOs to drop and pick from Kangundo Bus park failure to which their routes are revoked.
2. Enforce picking and dropping from the Bus Park.
3. Organize sensitization and awareness meeting between the residents, business community, County Government and the administration of Kangundo Sub County.
4. Operationalize the toilets at the Bus Park.
5. Replace the vandalized steel.
6. Re-launch the operationalization of the Bus Park with the SACCOs in operation.
