#### (b) Response on statement status of Community Health Promoters – (Hon. Vincent Mutie, Chairperson, Health and Emergency Services)

**Honorable Speaker**, Standing Order 41(3) provides that where a member requests for a statement from the Committee Chairperson relating to matters under the mandate of the Committee, the Speaker may either appoint a day for the statement or direct that the statement sought must be restricted to matters within the mandate of the Committee and which have been exhaustively dealt with and concluded by the Committee or where the Chairperson is authorized by members to issue preliminary reports to the house.

**Honorable Speaker**, on 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 during the morning plenary sitting, a Statement on status of community health promoters in the county by Hon. Raphael Lucky (MCA, Matungulu West) was sought seeking the following:

- i) We are in the know about the new developments on the Community Health Promoters in our County, what plans has the Department of Health and Emergency Services put in place to ensure payment of arrears of the laid off Community Health Promoters?
- ii) How prepared is the Department on the newly recruited Community Health Promoters in terms of their welfare, pay and Capacity Building

**Honorable Speaker**, in response to the above statement, the committee requested from the Chief Officer, Public Health and the department responded to the aforementioned statement through a letter that:

Machakos County has 2870 community Health promoters (CHPs) in 287 community health Units across the county. The CHPs are served by 43 Community health Assistants (CHAS).

Below is the distribution of the CHPS per Sub County.

The CHPS undergo Basic and Technical modules to equip them with knowledge and skill to address health matters at L 1 service (household level). Out of the 2870 chps, 2311 chps are trained on both basic and technical modules and the remaining 559 are in the process of being trained.

The Department received 2877 phones/phone cover and 2877kits from the National Government. All the kits have so far been distributed to the CHPs. Distribution of medicines has been done to the sub counties to issuance to eligible CHPs who are trained on handling the medicine and other equipment. The CHPs will be trained on Electronic Community Information System (Echis) on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2024.

The Department of Health and Emergency services has streamlined payment of CHPS stipend of two thousand and five hundred shillings (2500) per month. The CHPs have been paid for the months of November and December, 2023 and the January payment is being processed. The department is yet to receive the National share 50%, hence 50:50 to give a total of 5000 shillings per month.
