## (b) <u>Statement on Status of Matuu Hospital Loop and Equity Lane roads (Hon. Judas Ndawa; MCA, Matuu Ward)</u>

Hon Speaker, that aware that Article 185 (3) of the Constitution states that the County Assembly, while respecting the principle of separation of powers, may exercise oversight over the County Executive Committee Members and any other County Executive Organs. Aware that under the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution, County Governments are responsible for County Transport including county roads, traffic, parking and public road transport; Aware that in the previous regime the Assembly allocated funds for construction of flagship projects in various wards including road projects. Informed that during the period Matuu Hospital Loop Road and Matuu Equity Lane Road which are in Matuu Ward were among the projects. Cognizant that most of the works in these projects have been done and only few works remaining to be completed.
