Honorable Speaker, the House Business Committee met today, Wednesday 8th July, 2026 to prioritize business for the House as forwarded by Committees and Honorable Members pursuant to the provisions of the Standing Order 151(6)(d). The Committee balloted business as follows;

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(b) Request of statement concerning the Municipal Manager of Tala / Kangundo Municipality (Hon. Francis Kavyu, Minority Leader / MCA, Kinanie Ward)

Hon. Speaker, Aware that Sections 9, 13 and 28 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011 provide for the establishment of municipalities, the establishment of a Municipal Board for every municipality, and the office of the Municipal Manager, respectively;

Aware that the Municipal Manager is the chief executive officer of the municipality, responsible for implementing the decisions and functions of the Municipal Board and accountable to the Board;

Further aware that Section 29 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011 provides that a Municipal Manager shall be competitively recruited and appointed by the County Public Service Board established under Section 57 of the County Governments Act, 2012;

Further aware that Section 30 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011 prescribes the qualifications for appointment as a Municipal Manager, including that the person must be a citizen of Kenya, hold a degree from a university recognized in Kenya or its equivalent, possess not less than ten (10) years' proven experience in administration or management in either the public or private sector, and satisfy the requirements of Article 232 and Chapter Six of the Constitution;

Hon. Speaker, Pursuant to Standing Order No. 41, I wish to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Justice and Legal Affairs Committee on the following matters regarding the appointment of the current Municipal Manager for Kangundo/Tala Municipality:

- a. To state the date on which the current Municipal Manager for Kangundo/Tala Municipality was appointed and table a copy of the letter of appointment.
- b. To provide evidence demonstrating that the appointment was undertaken through a competitive recruitment process in accordance with Sections 29 and 30 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011, Article 232 of the Constitution, and all other applicable constitutional and statutory provisions governing appointments to public office.

(c) Request of a Statement on whether the County Government will assist the traders of Machakos town Mitumba market whose businesses were destroyed by fire on 4th July, 2026 (Hon. Francis Ngunga, Deputy Minority Leader / MCA, Mua Ward)

Honorable Speaker, AWARE THAT Part 2 (12) of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya provides that the functions of the County government include Firefighting services and disaster management.

Aware that there was a fire outbreak in Machakos Mitumba Market which consumed most part of the market and the emergency response from the Department of Firefighting and Emergency Services is wanting.

Further Aware that Section 110 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 provides for the establishment of the County Government Emergency Fund where the purpose of the fund is to enable payments to be made in respect of a County when an urgent and unforeseen need for expenditure for which there is no specific legislative authority arises.

Honorable Speaker, pursuant to the Standing Order No. 41 of the Assembly Standing Orders, I wish to seek a statement from the Chairperson of the Assembly Committee on Decentralized units concerning the following matters: -

- ii) The measures that the County Executive is putting in place to ensure restoration of the Machakos Mitumba Market and curb such future fire occurrences.
- iii) Whether the CECM Finance has invoked the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act on the Emergency Fund.
